

Talk for Work: a free 80-minute workshop to help support communication skills in your organisation

Background: lots of young people have difficulties with aspects of communication which can disadvantage them at school and in the workplace. Difficulties can be hard to identify...so young people don't always get the support they need to make progress. Ultimately this can lead to underachievement and difficulties finding employment.

How does this training help? Talk for Work is delivered by our school staff and students together. It will help your staff to:

- be more aware of the skills involved in communication and where it can go wrong
- understand how communication difficulties can affect performance in the workplace
- learn some practical ways to support young people with these difficulties to better do the job you need.
