Improving the lives of people with severe or profound learning disabilities and behaviours that challenge, and their families, by building regional networks

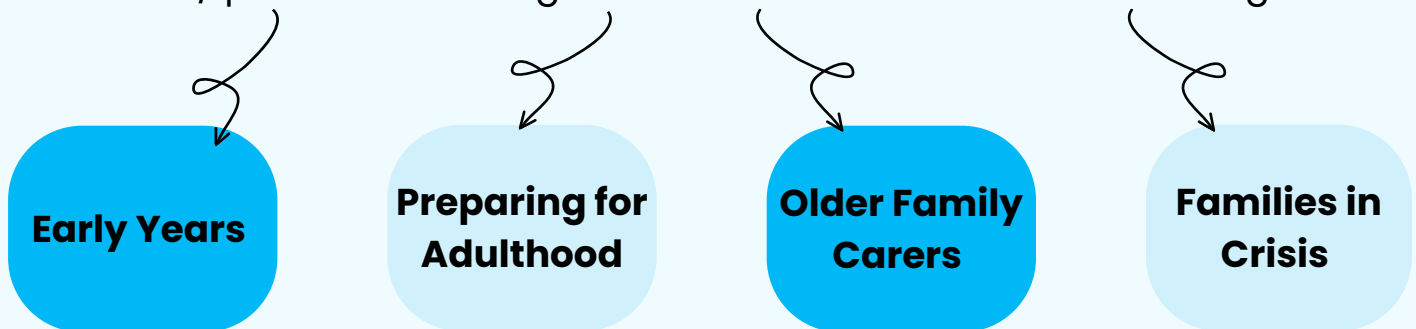


The Forward Together project is working within three areas of England: Kent and Medway, the Black Country, and Salford and Manchester.
